## Resolution from Supplementary Committee Meeting Held at Harbour House, Itchenor On 02 February 2018 at 09.30

## OLD HAVEN

The Parish Council has asked the Society to join them in the forthcoming Appeal regarding Old Haven. The owner of Old Haven has asked the Planning Inspector for a three day Public Inquiry to enable full consideration of his appeal, however, CDC has requested a Hearing, which is only one day. The Parish Council would like to contest this appeal, as a Rule 6 party for which there are a number of advantages. The Itchenor Society agreed to join the WIPC in their application for Rule 6 status. To initiate the proceedings the Society agreed to give up to a maximum of £3000. However, the total costs for the Public Enquiry are expected to be around £50,000. To raise this money the WIPC and Itchenor Society, will approach the village for pledges, which the Society will facilitate. Pledges will be anonymous.

- The Itchenor Society will host an e-mail account in which pledges will be recorded
- The Itchenor Society will host a bank account that will be used to collect funds and pay for expert witnesses and barristers
- The Itchenor Society will not be responsible for any of the contractual relationships between the Village and the expert witnesses and barristers.
